Change method of applying silicone sealant to prevent it from squeezing under and dislodging sealing ring when drawing sections together:

Apply continuous bead of silicone sealant no larger than 1/16" around entire outside edge of machined surface (see Figure below). Do not apply silicone sealant on, next to or under sealing ring.



Silicone sealant, when applied as specified above, prevents unburned oil vapors from coming in contact with sealing ring. Vapor contact can damage rings, resulting in severe damage to boiler and substantial property damage.
