

Commercial Cast Iron Boiler DOE-Compliant Design Transition Update

Valued Commercial Boiler Sales Network,

Please find the following product families that are planned for new, higher efficiency design and series manufacture following the upcoming 01/10/23 DOE regulatory change.

- LGB Family Series 3 steam and water boilers
- 88 Family Series 3 water boilers

<u>Note</u>: There are no changes planned for the current 88 Family Series 2 Steam boilers as it already meets the upcoming DOE regulatory requirements.

Based on this transition to the new design

- We will continue to accept orders of the current part number though 8/29.
- Orders on 9/1 or later, will use the new part numbers.

As a reminder, you will be able to continue to order repair/replacement sections and parts for these series boilers after the last order window passes.

- LGB Family Series 2 steam and water boilers
- 88 Family Series 2 water boilers

Every effort to ship all open orders prior to 01/10/23 will be made. In the event that orders outpace production capacity, the option to convert existing orders to the new design series / alternate product offering or cancel the order at no charge will be at the customer's discretion. If additional production capacity becomes available due to DOE regulation change, Weil-McLain will publish notice of additional order capacity to the sales channel.

New Part Numbers & Pricing

- New design part numbers and trade pricing will be provided for the new LGB and 88 water models prior to 08/29/22.
- Orders received for new design models will be processed starting 09/01/22.
- Weil-McLain will not be implementing a pricing change at this time for equivalent configurations of the 88 and LGB.
