

Recent PEG / EG Boiler Supply Tapping Changes

Weil-McLain originally implemented a rolling change on October 17, 2018 to eliminate the optional right end section supply tapping (3") on EG block assemblies and PEG steam gas boilers. The first PEG boiler serial number was CP7705589.

Due to customer requests for supply piping options (desire to install two risers for sizes PEG/EG 40-50), Weil-McLain will revert to the prior process that provides the 3" supply tapping in the right end section of all the EG block assemblies and PEG boilers. Our Eden facility will begin assembly and start shipping to distributors in February.

Weil-McLain's current design of PEG/EG boilers provide better heating operation than older models, and only require one riser. For steam applications, the boiler manual instructs to install the supply pipe on the same end section as the controls. PEG boiler controls are on the left end section, packaged as such. The current EG block assemblies and PEG boilers in your stock can be (and are recommended to be) installed utilizing the one existing left end section supply tapping.
