



DOE New Minimum Efficiency Levels for Residential Boilers: CGi & CGa

Valued Distributor,

The Department of Energy (DOE) is raising efficiency levels next year for residential gas and oil boilers (under 300,000 Btuh input). Weil-McLain will be improving efficiency levels on the following products:

- CGa
- CGi
- EG (Water)
- SGO
- WGO & WTGO

The new rules apply to what Weil-McLain and other manufacturers produce, and not what distribution and contractors can sell. Anything that is purchased from Weil-McLain can continue to be sold, installed, and serviced.

Weil-McLain residential boiler that will be *discontinued*:

- CGt – quantities should be available throughout the summer, while supplies last.

PHASE 1: New CGa Series 3 and CGi Series 4 Boilers, all at 84% AFUE

During the 2nd Quarter of this year, 2020, Weil-McLain will begin the rolling production change to a new **CGa Series 3** and **CGi Series 4** line of boilers. New part numbers and pricing are included in this year's Trade Price Schedule #59 (TPS#59, effective 4/1/20), which is now available in the distributor section of our website.

Not only will all sizes have an 84% AFUE rating, but will also have a new appearance and built-in low water cut off. Click on links below to view the sales flyers.
