SUBJECT: Quick Response (QR) Codes

Over the years, social media has exploded in popularity by connecting people together with technology. Weil-McLain has been keeping up with the social media trend through various social media sites (Facebook, YouTube, and Twitter), which has allowed us to better connect with our customers. Our next focus will be to incorporate a new way that will allow us to utilize the latest social trend of mobile marketing.

We are currently in the beginning stages of integrating an exciting new marketing channel that will allow our customers to quickly and easily access information about our products. This newly integrated channel is known as **QR codes** or **Quick Response codes**.

QR codes share many similarities to barcodes used by retailers to track inventory and price products. The key difference is the amount of data each can hold. Unlike barcodes that only hold up to 20 numerical digits, QR codes are two-dimensional (2D) matrix barcodes that can hold thousands of alphanumeric characters of information. QR codes consist of black modules arranged in a square pattern on a white background which is scanned with your smartphone (e.g. iPhone, Android, or Blackberry devices) camera and a specialized app. Once scanned, the encoded information may be in the form of URL links, geo coordinates, text, or other data.



Weil-McLain plans to integrate new QR codes on **boiler** carton labels, boiler rating labels, product literature, and trade ads. Once scanned, the QR codes will direct you to the specific product's mobile website where information and content (e.g. brochure, user manual, boiler manual, YouTube, Facebook, Twitter, etc.) can be easily accessed at the convenience of your smartphone.

To scan our QR codes requires a specialized QR code scanner/reader app on your smartphone. To download the

app, go to the Apple App Store (iPhone), the Android Market (Android), or the Blackberry App World (go to <u>www.blackberry.com/appworld/download</u> to download the app store on your Blackberry if not already installed) on your smartphone and search **QR code reader** in the search bar. A list of compatible QR code scanner/reader applications should result. Choose and download an app you like and **try it out on the QR code image included on**

this bulletin. We are confident that this new feature will provide you with a quick, fun, and exciting way to access information about Weil-McLain products.
